ACCESS BY AIR

Furthermore, there are several flights daily to major German hubs such as Frankfurt or Munich. Delegates may also fly to Berlin and continue their journey by train. The train journey from Berlin Central Station to Leipzig takes only one hour, and trains run hourly.

BY TRAIN

Leipzig Central Station puts Leipzig right in the center of Europe’s railway network. The fast and comfortable ICE trains provide for good direct connections to all major German cities and many cities in Europe.

BY CAR

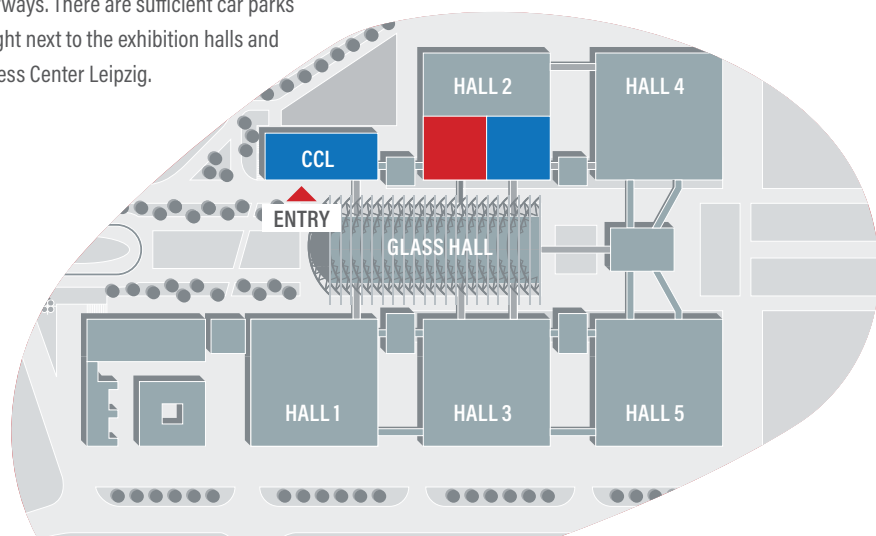
